## Pride Bible Verses

**Leviticus 26:19.** I will break down your stubborn pride and make the sky above you like iron and the ground beneath you like bronze.

**2 Kings 19:22.** Who is it you have ridiculed and blasphemed? Against whom have you raised your voice and lifted your eyes in pride? Against the Holy One of Israel!

**2 Chronicles 26:16.** But after Uzziah became powerful, his pride led to his downfall. He was unfaithful to the LORD his God, and entered the temple of the LORD to burn incense on the altar of incense.

**2 Chronicles 32:26.** Then Hezekiah repented of the pride of his heart, as did the people of Jerusalem; therefore the LORD's wrath did not come on them during the days of Hezekiah.

**Job 20:6.** Though the pride of the godless person reaches to the heavens and his head touches the clouds,

**Job 33: 17.** to turn them from wrongdoing and keep them from pride,

**Psalms 10:4.** In his pride the wicked man does not seek him; in all his thoughts there is no room for God.

**Psalms 31:18.** Let their lying lips be silenced, for with pride and contempt

they speak arrogantly against the righteous.

**Psalm 56:2.** My adversaries pursue me all day long; in their pride many are attacking me.

**Psalm 59:12.** For the sins of their mouths, for the words of their lips, let them be caught in their pride. For the curses and lies they utter,

**Psalm 73:6.** Therefore pride is their necklace; they clothe themselves with violence.

**Proverbs 8:13.** To fear the LORD is to hate evil; I hate pride and arrogance, evil behavior and perverse speech.

**Proverbs 11:2.** When pride comes, then comes disgrace, but with humility comes wisdom.

**Proverbs 13:10.** Where there is strife, there is pride, but wisdom is found in those who take advice.

**Proverbs 14:3.** A fool's mouth lashes out with pride, but the lips of the wise protect them.

**Proverbs 16:18.** Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall.

**Proverbs 29:23.** Pride brings a person low, but the lowly in spirit gain honor.

**Ecclesiastes 7:8.** The end of a matter is better than its beginning, and patience is better than pride.

**Isaiah 2:11.** The eyes of the arrogant will be humbled and human pride brought low; the LORD alone will be exalted in that day.

**Isaiah 2:17.** The arrogance of man will be brought low and human pride humbled; the LORD alone will be exalted in that day,

**Isaiah 10:12.** When the Lord has finished all his work against Mount Zion and Jerusalem, he will say, “I will punish the king of Assyria for the willful pride of his heart and the haughty look in his eyes.

**Isaiah 13:9.** Babylon, the jewel of kingdoms, the pride and glory of the Babylonians, will be overthrown by God like Sodom and Gomorrah.

**Isaiah 16:6.** We have heard of Moab’s pride— how great is her arrogance!— of her conceit, her pride and her insolence; but her boasts are empty.

**Isaiah 23:9.** The LORD Almighty planned it, to bring down her pride in all her splendor and to humble all who are renowned on the earth.

**Isaiah 25:11.** They will stretch out their hands in it, as swimmers stretch out their hands to swim. God will bring down their pride despite the cleverness of their hands.

**Isaiah 37:23.** Who is it you have ridiculed and blasphemed? Against whom have you raised your voice and lifted your eyes in pride? Against the Holy One of Israel!

**Jeremiah 13:9.** “This is what the LORD says: ‘In the same way I will ruin the pride of Judah and the great pride of Jerusalem.

**Jeremiah 13:17.** If you do not listen, I will weep in secret because of your pride; my eyes will weep bitterly, overflowing with tears, because the LORD’s flock will be taken captive.

**Jeremiah 48:29.** “We have heard of Moab’s pride— how great is her arrogance!— of her insolence, her pride, her conceit and the haughtiness of her heart.

**Jeremiah 49:16.** The terror you inspire and the pride of your heart have deceived you, you who live in the clefts of the rocks, who occupy the heights of the hill. Though you build your nest as high as the eagle’s, from

there I will bring you down,” declares the LORD.

**Ezekiel 7:20.** They took pride in their beautiful jewelry and used it to make their detestable idols. They made it into vile images; therefore I will make it a thing unclean for them.

**Ezekiel 7:24.** I will bring the most wicked of nations to take possession of their houses. I will put an end to the pride of the mighty, and their sanctuaries will be desecrated.

**Ezekiel 16:56 .** You would not even mention your sister Sodom in the day of your pride,

**Ezekiel 24:21.** Say to the people of Israel, ‘This is what the Sovereign LORD says: I am about to desecrate my sanctuary—the stronghold in which you take pride, the delight of your eyes, the object of your affection. The sons and daughters you left behind will fall by the sword.

**Ezekiel 28:2.** “Son of man, say to the ruler of Tyre, ‘This is what the Sovereign LORD says: “‘In the pride of your heart you say, “I am a god; I sit on the throne of a god in the heart of the seas.” But you are a mere mortal and not a god, though you think you are as wise as a god.

**Ezekiel 32:12.** I will cause your hordes to fall by the swords of mighty men—the most ruthless of all nations. They will shatter the pride of Egypt, and all her hordes will be overthrown.

**Daniel 5:20.** But when his heart became arrogant and hardened with pride, he was deposed from his royal throne and stripped of his glory.

**Daniel 11:12.** When the army is carried off, the king of the South will be filled with pride and will slaughter many thousands, yet he will not remain triumphant.

**Amos 6:8.** The Sovereign LORD has sworn by himself—the LORD God Almighty declares: “I abhor the pride of Jacob and detest his fortresses; I

will deliver up the city and everything in it.”

**Amos 8:7.** The LORD has sworn by himself, the Pride of Jacob: “I will never forget anything they have done.

**Obadiah 1:3.** The pride of your heart has deceived you, you who live in the clefts of the rocks and make your home on the heights, you who say to yourself, ‘Who can bring me down to the ground?’

**Zephaniah 2:10.** This is what they will get in return for their pride, for insulting and mocking the people of the LORD Almighty.

**Zechariah 9:6.** A mongrel people will occupy Ashdod, and I will put an end to the pride of the Philistines.

**Zechariah 10:11.** They will pass through the sea of trouble; the surging sea will be subdued and all the depths of the Nile will dry up. Assyria’s pride will be brought down and Egypt’s scepter will pass away.

**1 John 2:15-17.** Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in them. For everything in the world---the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life--comes not from the Father but from the world. The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever.
